LiquidHub's Jonathan Brassington Named Philadelphia "40 Under 40" Award Recipient

The awards program, in its 15th year, recognizes 40 individuals from the Greater Philadelphia Region who are under the age of 40 and proven performers in their respective industries and communities. Winners were profiled in a special section of the Journal's April 8-14, 2005 edition.

Brassington has been a technology thought leader throughout his career. He is Chief Executive Officer, President, and Founding Partner of LiquidHub, a strategic technology consulting firm with offices in Philadelphia, PA; Boston, MA; and Hyderabad, India. On a personal level, Brassington was the recipient of the 2004 Young Alumni award from College Misericordia for his demonstrated leadership, community service, and excellence. In 2000, Brassington was honored as one of the Philadelphia "30 Under 30" where he was featured as a regional technology leader. He is a volunteer for the American Red Cross, serves as a committee member of the Program Team for the Philadelphia Chapter of the Society of Information Managers, and is an Advisory Board Member on Institutional Advancement for his alma mater, College Misericordia.

Recipients will be honored at the "40 Under 40" awards banquet themed "Unrealized Goals: the Best Is Yet to Come" to be held on April 26, 2005 at the Sheraton Society Hill in Philadelphia, PA. More than 600 regional business leaders are expected to attend.
